# 1TF ENGLAND NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS 8<sup>th</sup> FEBRUARY 2025

ENTRY CLOSES: Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> February at 23.59

Only members affiliated to ITF England are eligible to participate. This event is only open to England affiliates so every medallist is an official ITFE English Champion for that year.

### AGE RANGES – Male and Female Categories split

- Child: (born in 2016 or after)
- Cadet: (born in 2013, 2014 or 2015)
- Pre-Jnr: (born in 2010, 2011 or 2012)
- Jnr: (born in 2007, 2008 or 2009)
- Adult: (born from 1989 to 2006)
- Senior: (born in 1988 or before or can choose to enter the Adult category but cannot do both & must use 1989 as the year of birth)

### **ENTRY FEES**

Affiliates can only enter as individual clubs rather than as an Association. Apply with your school name and instructor, once accepted you will be able to apply to enter this event. Instructors will receive a unique login and password to access their account.

### **COMPETITOR ATTIRE**

All competitors must wear a white ITF dobok showing the ITF logo from the ITF affiliated to the ITF <a href="https://itftkd.sport">https://itftkd.sport</a> (no traditional doboks) from an ITF approved supplier that displays this logo.



The exception is in the case a group that has recently joined ITFE and will be upgrading their dobok within 12 months of joining. Doboks with National Team names (ie England) and national flags are not allowed and must be covered. Junior black belts must have a white stripe through the middle.



Failure to comply with the above will result in the competitor being unable to compete.

For very young competitors from a kids program, they will be allowed to wear the belt from that program (with stripes and tags), however it's essential they are only registered in the appropriate categories i.e. 10<sup>th</sup>/9<sup>th</sup> kup.

### **SPECTATOR FEES**

Paid for on the day. Spectators cannot enter the competition area.

4yrs and under Free 5-15yrs £3 16yrs+ £5

### **COACHES FEES**

Each club will be allocated a number of coach bands based on the number of competitors they have taking part. The cost for a Coaches pass is £10 per coach. Competitors may coach one another at no charge only if they are wearing the appropriate coaching attire. You will be able to add your coaches on your account. For colour belts coaches are not a requirement, however for Pre-Junior (red belts), Cadet and Adult black belts, coaches are a requirement in sparring.

### **COACHES ATTIRE**

Club T-shirt, track suit trousers, socks, training shoes and a towel. No coaching in dobok/sliders allowed.

### **REFEREES**

All clubs are requested to appoint the appropriate number of black belt umpires. Those black belts with no umpire training can still be used in helping the rings to function.

1-10 Competitors11-20 Competitors2 Umpires20+ Competitors3 Umpires

Clubs must pay a fine of £100 per missing umpire for their competitors to be able to participate. Please encourage more umpires to participate so we can ensure a smooth running of the event.

Selected National Team Members must umpire in the morning before competing in the afternoon.

### DRAW SYSTEM FOR PATTERN AND SPARRING

The traditional pyramid system will be used and where possible the tournament committee will seed the competitors in the black belt categories. Clickers will be used for both events.

There will be up to 1 gold, 1 silver and up to 2 bronze medals available for each division unless in special technique or power test where just one bronze medal will be available. These special medals are custom made, exclusive ITF England medals.

Only medals that are won can go towards points for overall competitors and Club awards. Medals can still be handed out in categories of 4 or less, but will not count towards overall points. Overall champions from each age range and from all three events will receive a special overall trophy. There will be 3 overall club trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. This is only available for clubs and not for associations who amalgamate students under one name.

By competing in this event, competitors will:

- Wear white official ITF dobok with approved branding (no country name)
- Pre-Junior and Junior Black belts wear a black belt with a white stripe
- Accept the competition schedule which may change
- Accept that the organizers may modify/merge a division and/or category based on the number of competitors by one division/category
- Accept the ITF Rules unless they differ according to these rules

6<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> Kups will perform a designated pattern of Won-Hyo or Yul-Gok
4<sup>th</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> Kups will perform a designated pattern of Joong-Gun or Toi-Gye
2<sup>nd</sup>/1<sup>st</sup> Kups will perform a designated pattern of Hwa-Rang or Choong-Moo

all belt colours – 1 designated pattern (of the lowest grade) Black Belts separated in degrees – 1 designated pattern from the three degree patterns or from the lowest degree if merged.

### Adult Male and Female separated

Separated into all belt colours – 1 designated pattern (of the lowest grade) Black Belts separated in degrees – 1 designated pattern from the three degree patterns or from the lowest degree if merged.


### Senior Male and Female separated

In the case any belt colours are merged the higher grade must perform the same pattern as the lower grade. In the case it is against a competitor from the white belt category, that competitor will announce whether they will perform Saju Jirugi, Saju Makgi or Chon–Ji and the higher belt must match that. Please ensure your competitor know the pattern for their grade.

### **WEIGH IN**

All competitors must height check/weigh in wearing a T shirt and dobok trousers only. A tolerance of .5kgs is allowed when weighing in. All competitors must be within their height/weight class, it will be possible to edit these details online up until the closing date. Any changes in weight class on the day of competing can incur a £10 charge.

### **COMPETITOR PROTECTION REQUIREMENTS**

This is mandatory for each age category. Groin guards are compulsory for male competitors over 135cms. Glasses cannot be worn during the Sparring event unless they are specific sports glasses for contact sports.

Child/Cadet: Mouth Guard, Head Guard, Closed fingered gloves, Groin guard (Male over 135cms), Feet Pads, Shin Guards

Pre-Jnr/Jnr/Adult/Senior: Mouth Guard, Head Guard, Closed fingered gloves, Groin guard (Male), Feet Pads (Shin pads are optional)

Mouth guards can be any colour and sparring gear does not need to be from an approved supplier, however they must follow the below standards:

- All Sparring gear must be in reasonable condition, if any equipment is falling apart then the competitor will have 3 minutes to change it.
- Closed fingered gloves: The thumb must be securely attached to the rest of the glove.
- No boxing gloves allowed
- No dipped foam sparring gear is allowed except head guards.
- Boots must cover the toes and heel.
- Groin guards must be worn on the inside of the trousers.

### **CONTACT RULES**

Light contact rules apply, contact to the face is allowed in all age categories, however any hard contact to the face or body especially in the llyrs and under age categories can result in a foul or immediate disqualification. For safety reasons we want to encourage all Child & Cadets to aim towards hitting the headguard rather than the face with light contact. Ilyrs and under are not allowed to kick in a straight line to the face. This can result in a foul or immediate disqualification if deemed dangerous.

Flying High Kick Starting height is the height category + 10cms (an extra 10cms for +155cms and +165cms)

### **RULES**

## All Child/Cadets/Pre-Juniors/Juniors Colour belts

Each competitor will get two attempts at hitting the flying high kick (using the ball of the foot). 3 points will be awarded if they kick the board all the way back with the high kick. If the board only goes half way then just 1 point will be awarded. Those with the most points go to the next round.

If the competitor misses the target then they will get a 2<sup>nd</sup> go straight away. If they just move the board half way and the umpires award 1 point then the competitor can choose to go again and better that attempt. If they miss on the second attempt then they will have 1pt for that technique.

The competitors will keep going higher until the winners are decided.

### All Under Pre-Junior/Junior/Adult Black belts

All Black Belt competitors in the above categories will have 1 measure (prejudge) then one attempt on each technique. Everyone completes each technique in the above order with the first three techniques in a row i.e. all competitors perform Flying High Front Kick, Flying Turning Kick & Flying Reverse Turning Kick first, then all competitors perform Flying 360 Back Kick and Flying High Side Kick.

In the case of a draw after all techniques have been completed the Jury President will chose one technique at random as the decider for the next round until the winners are decided.

### **RULES**

Adult/Senior Colour Belts and Senior Black Belts select two techniques from the choices, one hand and one foot and they also choose the number of boards secretly to the Centre Referee prior to the start. In the event of a draw, competitors will have to perform the techniques that they have not chosen in the second round and again give the number of boards to the umpire. Both techniques will be required. If there is still a draw then the Jury President will select a technique at random and the number of boards until the winners are decided.

### **RULES**

All Junior & Adult Black Belt competitors will have 1 measure (pre-judge) then one attempt on each technique. Everyone completes each technique in any order they like.

Medals can only be given out to competitors who have gained some points. 2 Bronzes will only be awarded if the competitors are on the same number of points. If there is only one competitor in the division then they must score points to win the medal.

3 points for a broken board and 1 point for a bent board.

### **Draws**

Draws will only be created once all competitors have signed in on the ring as our system changes the draws automatically. You will have access to the schedule for each individual competitor and the number of competitors I each category once everyone is registered through the online portal that will be available at <a href="https://www.itfengland.com">www.itfengland.com</a>

### **REGISTRATION**

Before individuals can register, their club must be listed. Therefore clubs looking to participate will need to apply by using the link on the main competition page at <a href="www.itfengland.com">www.itfengland.com</a>, once the club is registered then either the individuals can register themselves or instructors can choose to register their competitors themselves on the same page. It will be possible to edit all entries once listed online and the instructor will have access to their students entries. Payment must be made by the deadline on 2<sup>nd</sup> February by the club based on the number of entries they have on their system.

Registration will be open from 1<sup>st</sup> December 2024 and closes on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2025 at midnight.

### SPECTATOR INTERFERANCE

To ensure smooth running of the competition if any spectators, competitors or coaches are rude towards the organiser, referees or other competitors, then they will be asked to leave the competition venue immediately and risk that the competitor may be disqualified from all events including future AETA Competitions until further notice.

### **PROTEST**

There will be no protest fee. If a coach wishes to dispute a result please approach one of the Tournament Committee members and we will be happy to discuss it. If coaches are rude towards committee members they will not have the opportunity to put their point across. Parents cannot dispute a result with the umpires.

### **PHOTOGRAPHY**

We will have the professional photography company DE Photo taking pictures throughout the weekend. ITF England will also have their official photographer present, no other photographers will be allowed access to the floor.

### **INSURANCE**

Participation is at your own risk. The organisation is not responsible for any injuries which might happen during the event. We recommend that your competitors are in possession of an insurance, which covers any problem that might occur during traveling and participation to the event. Every competitor must be licenced with their association.

### CONCUSSION

Competitors that have received a concussion within 4 weeks of this event will not be able to participate. Please ensure the competitors are healthy before the closing date. By registering for this event you will be confirming that the competitor is healthy, concussion free and able to compete. You can remove competitors up until the closing on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> February.

### WELFARE/SAFEGUARDING

ITF England takes Welfare/Safeguarding very seriously and so we will have Welfare/Safeguarding officers at the event for any issues that may arise. These individuals will be presented at the beginning of the day so participants can recognise who they are.
